



Regulation Bulletin 1

Change to requirement for Structural Integrity Certificate

This Bulletin is issued to formalise a change in wording of regulation 2.6.2

Background:

Version 1 of regulation 2.6.2 called for a 'Structural Integrity Certificate' to be provided as part of the event documentation.

Amendment:

2.6.2

Structural Report. Entrants are required to have their vehicle certified by a suitably qualified professional engineer as having been designed and constructed to be fit for purpose, and having the structural integrity to be driven on public roads in the Event. The certification, on the approved form, will be required to be submitted to the Road Transport Authority at the time of scrutineering. It will also be required to be submitted in support of any application for pre-event on-road testing permits made to an Australian Road Transport Authority.

The 'approved form' will be supplied to registered Entrants.
