



Regulation Bulletin 4

Requirement for Electrical Drawings

Appendix 2 of the General regulations calls for electrical drawings compliant with Technical Regulation B.11.8/9. These numbers are not used in the 2011 event.

*The minimum requirements for electrical drawings are as follows:
The electrical drawing must show all the essential power circuits of the electrical equipment of the vehicle in schematic form. The drawing must include (but is not limited to) power generation devices (array etc.), power storage (battery/super-capacitors etc.) power bus and switching/isolation arrangements, motor, motor controller, auxiliary circuits and any umbilical cables employed.*

A separate drawing must show the outline of the car (plan view, front of car at top) clearly showing how emergency isolation is to be activated.

In addition to forming part of the documentation, a separate loose leaf A4 copy must be supplied which will form part of the Log Book
